## NYHAVN DESK 1945

When Finn Juhl established his first studio at the exclusive address of 33 Nyhavn in central Copenhagen in 1945, he designed a very simple desk with burnished steel legs, which came to shape his furniture design during the 1950s. The desk can be ordered with a drawer unit mounted with brackets, to further emphasize the floating lightness of the table.
